



5. Do you think the farming and killing of wild animals for clothing and fashion accessories is acceptable?





6. Do you think that feathers can be collected from birds like ostriches without causing harm to them?

















13. Do you think that animal-derived leather is biodegradable and environmentally sustainable?









16. Knowing that the leather industry contributes to the cruel farming and killing of cows, how likely are you to avoid leather?






